GOALS of the INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR

The *Italian Society of Veterinary Acupuncture (ItVAS/SIAV)* and *Section of Arezzo of Istituto Zooprofilattico Sperimentale of Regions Lazio and Tuscany (IZSLT)* have organized the **19th International Seminar on Veterinary Acupuncture** that is dedicated to the Disciplines that constitute Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) and to the Techniques that are an integral part of it. Alongside the traditional Disciplines such as Dietetics and Herbal Medicine, there are also traditional techniques, such as moxibustion and tuina, but also the so-called "modern" techniques, such as aqua-puncture, chromo-acupuncture, electrostimulation, and homotoxicology in Acupuncture. They are important in achieving a specialized clinical intervention and in implementing a global and holistic medical act they can be combined and often become a useful complement to the acupuncture session. On these topics will be discussed expert speakers in the different areas of TCM. To facilitate the exchange of professional experience, a session of case reports produced by colleagues experienced in Acupuncture complete the Seminar. The Seminar also includes a practice session distinct for animal species during which the speakers will discuss with colleagues on clinical issues.
